

Pennsylvania Masonic Youth Foundation DISTRICT YOUTH CHAIRMAN Volunteer Position Description



The District Youth Chairman is appointed annually by the District Deputy Grand Master to help Lodges in the District to interact with Masonic Youth, to develop new Masonic Youth Groups, to support the CHIP program (in cooperation with the District CHIP Coordinator) and to promote programs of the Pennsylvania Masonic Youth Foundation among the Lodges.

Specific Duties:

- a. Get to know each Lodge Youth Chairman in the District, and help him to promote LifeSkills, scholarships, the Masonic Youth Groups, CHIP, and other programs of the Pennsylvania Masonic Youth Foundation.
- b. Assist Lodges in scheduling youth programs, speakers, ritual exemplifications, videos, or youth assistance with Lodge projects, CHIP events, etc.
- c. Provide a point of contact within your District for the Pennsylvania Masonic Youth Foundation office staff.
- d. Attend official visits of the D.D.G.M. and speak on PMYF programs when called upon by the D.D.G.M.
- e. File reports of your activity with the D.D.G.M. and Board of Directors of the Pennsylvania Masonic Youth Foundation.
- f. Attend Masonic Youth programs, when invited, to learn more about the youth groups.
- g. Identify Masonic communities that would benefit from the inclusion of a Masonic Youth Group in its area.
- h. Conduct meetings, as needed, on establishing and developing Masonic Youth Groups in your District.
- i. Submit photographs and written material on Masonic Youth programs to the PMYF for possible inclusion in The Pennsylvania Freemason, or on the PMYF Website.
- j. Encourage financial support of the PMYF program, CHIP Events, and of local youth groups by individuals and Lodges.
