



## Pennsylvania Masonic Youth Foundation Call 'em All Information and Guidelines



### **What is Call 'em All?**

Call 'em All is a phone and text based messaging service that makes it easy for an individual to contact a large group of people via phone or text message by making only one call.

### **How does it work?**

The group organizer will have access to the Call 'em All website and phone system. That person will then be able to create text messages or record a phone message. Those messages will then be automatically delivered to recipients via the service. All messages will provide a single caller identification number of your choosing so your group members will know who is contacting them.

### **Who are the recipients?**

It's up to you! Using the website, you will be able to enter in the information of anyone you would like to receive your messages / calls. This includes youth group members, adult volunteers, parents, and friends of the organization. Just make sure you have permission to have them on your mailing list!

### **Who is the "group organizer" that will get access to this information?**

The Group Organizer will initially be the Bethel Guardian / Mother Advisor / Chapter Advisor. They must complete an Account Request Form, after which they will be issued a username and password. That person can share the username and password for their group with whomever they would like to have access to the system – such as a local youth leader or other adult volunteer. However, no matter who issues the call, the same caller identification number will always be displayed.

### **How often can we use this service?**

Each local Bethel / Assembly / Chapter has been allotted one 1 minute long phone call per person per week OR 4 text messages per person per week. Alternately, the group can use one 30 second phone call and 2 text messages per person per week.

### **What can we use this service for?**

The messages you broadcast can contain information only. Any phone offering items for sale or requesting donations are strictly prohibited. As an example, you can send out a message saying "Don't forget to sell your chicken BBQ tickets"; but, you cannot say "We have chicken BBQ tickets for sale, please call back to purchase some."
